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JOB DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Artistic Director, the Production Manager supervises all RHT productions to ensure that they are executed in a safe, efficient, effective, and timely manner while continuing to meet the theatre's standards of artistic excellence and fulfilling the mission and vision of the organization. The position is based primarily at the Theatre in Bethesda, but will also require occasional work at the Administrative Offices in Silver Spring as well as at the Production Facility in Rockville. This position will require significant weekend and evening hours.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee and manage the execution of all production elements of all RHT productions within the constraints of budget, time, safety, and personnel resources.
- Lead the Full-Time Production Team, including the Associate Production Manager / Company Manager, Technical Director and scene shop staff, Electrics Supervisor, Audio Supervisor, Costume Shop Manager, as well as various production Stage Management Staff, Crew, and Overhire positions.
- Develop, submit, and administer budgets for all production-related expenses, including salaries, equipment, fixed assets, production materials, and supplies, to ensure production funds are spent efficiently.
- Serve as primary contact for directors and designers regarding concept and design meetings, dates, and deadlines. Keep Artistic Director informed regarding the progress of designs and deadlines.
- Plan, evaluate, and supervise all technical aspects of production in coordination with Production Department Heads to scale designs to budget and review for safety and feasibility.
- Attend production meetings, rehearsals, previews, performances and special events as needed. Coordinate hiring of various production stage managers, electricians, audio master, technical director, properties manager, costume shop manager, run crew, and other production overhire.
- Develop, implement, and evaluate Production Department policies and procedures.
 Ensure compliance with Union & Safety regulations and ensure adherence to relevant codes & safety procedures.

- Oversee payroll and hiring paperwork process for all Production Department staff and overhires.
- Supervise planning and execution of maintenance of production-related facilities, equipment, and vehicles.
- Coordinate with Rentals Manager to approve and provide necessary production elements for Rentals and Special Events taking place in the Bethesda Theatre.
- Actively and positively collaborate with all departments.
- Serve as an off-hours emergency contact for the theatre. Coordinate with Facilties
 Manager and/or General Manager the resolution of any and all issues related to
 facilities that affect production-related activities to ensure that the activities occur as
 scheduled.
- Represent the Production Department as a member of RHT's Management Team and facilitate communication as needed. Attend RHT Board meetings as necessary.
- Participation in RHT's equity, diversity, inclusion, and accessibility (EDIA) efforts, helping to fulfill and promote our mission and values.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND CAPABILITIES

- Bachelor's degree in Theatre or Arts Management -related major or equivalent work experience.
- 3-5 years of experience in production management, stage management, or comparable work preferred.
- Proficiency with MS Office and general aptitude for using computers.
- Driver's license required, own car preferred.
- Demonstrated management and leadership skills.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
- Demonstrated financial accounting ability.
- General knowledge of technical theatre required, including: stage management, carpentry, sound, electrics, scenic art, etc.
- Demonstrated ability to handle multiple projects simultaneously with attention to detail and deadlines.
